<p>Purpose of the processing of personal data</p>	<p>The purpose of this data processing is to identify and authenticate users of ANSET-Cloud service</p>
<p>Legal basis of processing</p>	<p>Legal basis for processing your personal data for the Service is your consent. You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.</p>
<p>Withdrawal of consent</p>	<p>The data subject shall have the right to withdraw his or her consent at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal. Prior to giving consent, the data subject shall be informed thereof.</p>
<p>Parties to whom personal data is disclosed</p>	<p>We may share your personal data with other members of the collaboration you have chosen to join. By joining a collaboration that is using the Service, you agree that your personal data may be disclosed to other authorised participants of the collaboration via secured mechanisms, but only for the same purposes and only as far as necessary to provide the services.</p> <p>The Service will share your personal data with services available to the collaboration you choose to become a member of. These services may be based in the EU/EEA, or in countries with less adequate data protection provisions.
